Dear Provider:

On behalf of the Committee on Minimum Continuing Legal Education, I am pleased to advise you that the Committee has approved you as a Provider under section 9 of the MCLE Rules and Regulations for the approval period listed above, subject to section 9.4. We will send you renewal information well in advance of the expiration date.

Effective September 1, 1997, MCLE Rule 2.1.2 places a limitation of 6 hours on the amount of credit that may be claimed by attorneys for education activities dealing with emotional distress. This will require you, as a provider, to separate the credit you give for prevention, detection, and treatment of substance abuse, from that you give pertaining to emotional distress.

It is the responsibility of the Provider to determine whether a presenter/instructor's topic includes any subfield credit, and to accurately compute the hours of California MCLE credit. Keep in mind that no credit is granted for coffee and stretch breaks, mealtimes, and topics covering MCLE Rule 2.1.1. in which the primary emphasis is on selling or marketing of legal services to increase the attorney's business.

You should review section 7 of the MCLE Rules and Regulations for your obligation for maintenance of records, inclusion of language in promotional materials, and provision of a certificate of attendance for members.

We enclose a State Bar of California approved Education Activity Evaluation Form. You may wish to add other items to the reverse side of this approved form. If you wish to develop a different form, you must include the information from the State Bar approved evaluation form. Additionally, please find enclosed sample Official Record of Attendance and Certificate of Attendance forms for California MCLE.

The State Bar encourages elimination of bias by urging all providers to select presenters/instructors without regard to sex, color, race, religion, ancestry, national origin, disability, age, and sexual orientation. We solicit your support for this policy.
